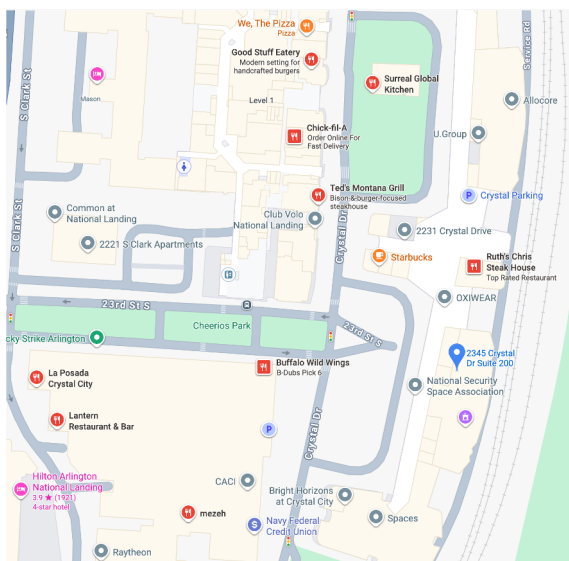
The 2025 ERII Counterespionage Conference will be held in Rooms 203/204 of Suite 200. Please see the diagram below for additional information.
